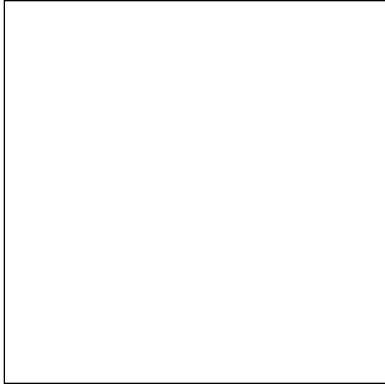

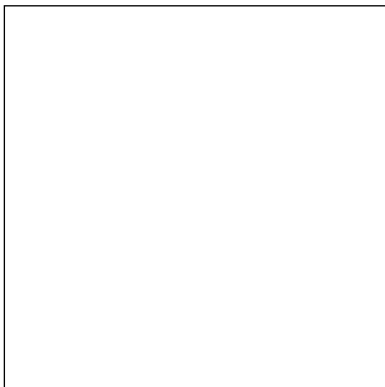

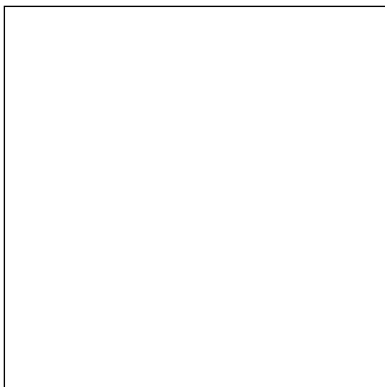

**Peter's Mother**

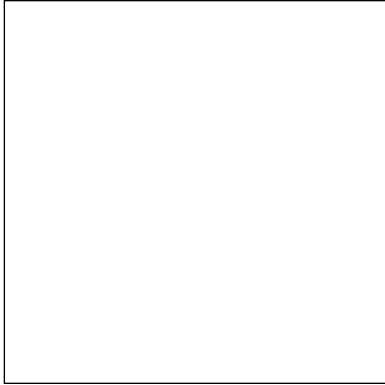
